NEW BUSINESS:

1. Concerts

This Wednesday, July 15, the Novi Concert Bank will be performing at the Villa. There was discussion on whether to do pizza sales or not. The Commission decided to sell water and pop and not do pizza sales at the July 15 concert. The G.L. Bums will be performing at Riley Park on Wednesday, August 19.

It is felt that signage is needed for the week of the concerts. Banners would be a huge benefit in drawing a bigger crowd. Banner have been seen them at Staples and it seemed as though they weren't too expensive.

Commissioner Cheney has a lead on a band that is willing to perform for free in order to gain exposure. They will be getting back to him with dates that they are available and he will let the Commission know via email.

Chairman Tim Moore said that he had a lot of compliments on the parade this year. The Commission felt the parade was very well attended and we had the largest group of parade attendees.

2. Movies in the Park

The movie "Paddington Bear" will be shown on Friday, July 31 at Sims Park. City businesses have donated \$850. Commissioner Costanzo has done fliers and distributed them to local business and posted them in the City parks.
