#### **NEW BUSINESS:**

#### 1. East Walled Lake Drive Parking

DDA Managing Director Jaquays described the schematic completed by Boss Engineering that proposed an ADA compliant design for the parking and sidewalks along East Walled Lake Drive.

DDA Chairman Ambrose asked if any further discussion has been held with the property owners?

Finance Director Pesta said we are still in discussion with the property owners to get the required easements. Ms. Pesta said the focus has been on ADA compliance.

DDA Board Member Millen said being a property owner downtown, he thinks this is a great idea and he believes this is long overdue. Mr. Millen said there are businesses owners along there who park there for 12-14 hours a day, who take up the already limited parking downtown.

# 2. 2021/2022 Budget Discussion

DDA Managing Director Jaquays said City administration held its second budget workshop this past weekend. Ms. Jaquays summarized the highlights regarding the DDA's budget and said the DDA is financially prepared to move forward in addressing the infrastructure needs this year.

Finance Director Pesta clarified that the operating budget for this fiscal year is expected to be \$2.3 Million.

# 3. 2021 City Events

Finance Director Pesta said the City is planning to host their annual events this year; However, changes may need to happen to meet social distancing guidelines. Ms. Pesta said the City has been moving forward in preparation for Memorial Day. Ms. Pesta said in lieu of a parade, the City will have a socially distanced ceremony. Ms. Pesta said the Beach Party is still scheduled to happen however, this year's event will be different to accommodate social distancing guidelines.

DDA Chairman Ambrose noted that there are businesses and organization who want to put banners and lights across public right of ways. Mr. Ambrose suggested an ordinance be discussed to address proposals of such.

Finance Director Pesta said that is something that can be discussed with the City Planner.

Mayor Ackley asked for clarification on which areas Mr. Ambrose was concerned about?

DDA Chairman Ambrose clarified that it would be for local roads.

# 1. Public Safety Campus Update

Finance Director Pesta said the Public Safety Campus project has been steadily moving forward. Ms. Pesta said the water main has been installed.
